## ABOUT THE CENTER

The Center, established in January 1968 by the local Mental Health Association in conjunction with area county commissioners, is a Community Mental Health Center. Organized under Kansas Law, it is governed by a Board composed of citizens from each of the four participating counties and includes consumer and family member representation. The Center is staffed by licensed mental health professionals serving residents of Barton, Rice, Stafford and Pawnee Counties.

## WHO WE SERVE

The Center serves a wide range of individuals, from children to senior citizens, with a variety of concerns about school, family, marital, substance use and work-related difficulties, which range from mild to severe difficulties in facing everyday life. Services are provided regardless of race, color, national origin, age, disability, sex or income level.

## COMMUNITY SERVICES

The Center offers more intensive services to those who qualify through Community Support or Community Based Services. These programs assist people in being successful at home and in the community through case management, psychosocial group activities, attendant care, parent support, and peer support. Community Based Services through the SED Waiver program is available to eligible youth at risk of hospitalization or being removed from their home/community, with additional services of wraparound treatment planning, parent support and respite care.



## OPEN ACCESS

The Center for Counseling does not require referral or appointment for intake (initial appointment) or crisis services. Intake Schedule: Mon thru Thurs 8:00 AM to 1:00 PM

Intake Required Documents:

- Proof of Income (W2, Pay Stub)
- Insurance Card
- Photo ID

## CONFIDENTIALITY

All services are confidential except for that information that must be reported by law: if presenting a danger to self or others, and reports of abuse.

## FEE STRUCTURE

In addition to insurance and sliding scale fees, services may also be subsidized by tax levies from our four participating counties and state grant funds. Fees for services not covered by insurance are determined by using a sliding fee schedule based on income and number of people dependent on that income and range from 5% to 100% of \$160.00 per hour. Most insurance companies cover the cost of outpatient services partially. Payment is due at time of service. The Center does not deny services due to an inability to pay.
